Please note that some of the rehearsal dates may conflict with the BYTESized Production of Newsies. We are aware of this and will be working with the production team of Newsies to work best around the schedule to avoid impacting their rehearsals.

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATIONS - If you are not a current student and wish to participate, you must register before your audition. You must read all terms and conditions, check fee schedule and register before coming to auditions. All term fees must be paid in full for students to be able to participate. PLAU SUNOPSIS - We find ourselves in the undersea city of Bikini Bottom, inhabited by happy-go-lucky and ever-optimistic yellow sea sponge SpongeBob SquarePants and his equally quirky circle of friends and neighbours. Bikini Bottom's pleasant existence is abruptly interrupted when it is discovered that Mt. Humongous, a nearby volcano, will erupt within the next 48 hours and completely obliterate the town. SpongeBob, trying to prove to himself and the world that he is not "just a simple sponge," resolves to save the day when everybody else has given up all hope.

ROLES - There are several roles available for students. (See the character descriptions below) Many of these roles can be cast as any gender and is up to director's discretion. There are many lead roles as well as several opportunities for important supporting ensemble actors. The ensemble plays a significant part in this show. Several ensemble roles will also be cast as featured dancers to appear in the bigger dance numbers. Start becoming familiar with the show and find the role that will be right for you!

You will feel more confident if you familiarise yourself with the show's story and characters before auditions!

Please note the JR version is different from the Broadway/full version. We recommend listening to the Youth Edition as it will be what we will perform. The Broadway version however, is an excellent example of characterisation.

Genders and ages in character descriptions are an indication of the way the character is scripted, not of the actors that will be considered for that role. We encourage performers to audition for any roles they feel they suit and that suit their vocal range.

The most important element we consider in casting is diversity. After all, this is one of the main themes of the show. Find and celebrate diversity in body type, colour, race, gender, and age. That's what an ocean habitat looks like, that's how our world is, and that's the Bikini Bottom Way.

We always need extra volunteers with costumes, publicity, spotlights, set building, backstage help, and various other tasks! Please let us know if you or anyone you know is interested in any of these positions

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AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Auditions will occur on **Saturday, 20th April, from 10:00 am - 3:00 pm**, in groups of 10 at the BSBA studios.

Upon arrival, please check in at reception and hand in your AUDITION FORMS.

- * Each student needs to sign up for only one audition time. They will take turns performing their chosen monologue and song. And then follow a simple dance tutorial.
- * Please plan to arrive at least 10 minutes before your scheduled appointment time and please be prepared to stay 10-15 minutes past your scheduled appointment time.

The BSBA team provides a safe and encouraging environment during the audition process and we expect all students to be respectful and encouraging to each other. It's OK if your child hasn't performed in a show before or if it's their 20th time - encourage them to do their best-this is NOT "Broadway Bootcamp!"

HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR AUDITION

ACTING - Please prepare one of the attached monologues offered in this audition pack. Select the monologue that you think will be best for you or the character you would like most. Know that you are auditioning for ALL roles no matter what monologue or song you select! The monologues need not be memorised, although you should be familiar with them. Please look over specific roles/scenes you are interested in. The director may ask you to read any of these.

SiNGING - Students will also choose a song on the list provided in the audition pack. Music can be found in the link provided on our web page (where you got this audition pack from) We will provide the backing music on the day. You may also be asked to sing a few scales if needed.

Practice your monologue & song at home **A LOT!** This will ensure you are much more prepared, less nervous & deliver a more confident performance for auditions. We are looking for expression, creativity, preparedness, lots of energy, character, movement, solid vocal pitch, and clear volume. Try to act like the character while you are singing! This demonstrates potential, dedication, and enthusiasm for the character and the show.

CASTING

Casting is the **HARDEST** part of a show and the worst part of a director's job!

Auditions can be very competitive. Casting is a careful and thoughtful process. Our goal is to place a large number of students into a small number of roles, serve the integrity of the show, and do our best to make everyone happy. There is absolutely NO precasting and the production team does our best to cast the students who we feel will do the best in each role and everyone who auditions will be considered.

Unfortunately, there are always those who do not get the role they really wanted or don't get in the cast at all. This is hard to explain and even harder to deal with when it happens. PLEASE be understanding, kind and professional as you support those who are cast. As hard as it may be, try not to take it personally. Please accept the casting process and celebrate everyone's efforts!

With that said, we will do our best to cast as many students as possible.

REQUIRED FORMS - Please help your child fill out the attached audition form & contract accurately, with a signature from both student & parent/guardian and have them bring it to their audition.

Please carefully review the attached schedule and provide **ANU** conflicts. We will do our best to work around known student conflicts. All actors will be expected to attend all assigned rehearsals unless previously excused.

SHOW FEE - There are no additional show fees, although you will be asked to purchase small incidentals and a cast t-shirt! Incidentals include students' own stage make-up (we will guide you), and although many costume pieces are taken care of by us, we may ask for you to provide items like a basic tee, shorts, leggings, attire for underneath costumes, and coloured plimsoll/ canvas or dance shoes - we will let you know once you're cast.

Participating in the musical requires commitment and dedication.

REHEARSALS

Rehearsals will be held at the BSBA studios on:

Sundays From 12pm to 3 pm Wednesdays From 4:30pm to 7pm

NOTE - We will be adding a couple of full-day workshops (Dates To be advised)

Not all cast members may be needed at all rehearsals. A rehearsal schedule will be sent before the 1st rehearsal. It is important that cast members are on time for rehearsals and come prepared with their script, pencil, and comfortable clothing/shoes to dance. Unexcused absences may affect the student's participation and/or role in the show.

In theatre, every part is important to the success of the production. It is imperative that we have all students at required rehearsals. When you are absent, it affects everyone's ability to perform the scene. Any pre scheduled events need to be listed on your audition form under conflicts. BEHAVIOUR - All cast, crew and production team members are entitled to feel safe and be respected. Everyone is expected to contribute their best effort for their own success, as well as that of the production as a whole. Everyone is expected to behave in a respectful, responsible manner, treating others as they would hope to be treated. Everyone is expected to contribute to maintaining the cleanliness and quality of the rehearsal spaces. If inappropriate behaviour occurs, a production team member will speak with the student privately. Students will be given a fair opportunity to redirect their behaviour and participate appropriately. If inappropriate behaviour is continually a problem, the student's parents or guardian will be contacted, and may result in dismissal from the cast, or the production.

2. Be respectful & kind to the other actors. Rehearsals are a place to have fun and explore different characters, ideas and directions. We want everyone to feel safe and supported!

3. Be respectful of our space, our props, sets, costumes, etc.

4. Always give your BEST! Give 100 % to your singing, acting & dancing!

5. Listen to instructions and follow directions the 1st time.

6. Go with the flow! Sometimes things change and we have to be ready to just move on.

7. Be Prepared! Always bring your script and a pencil/eraser to make notes and write down blocking.

8. Be Fun & Have Fun!

SCRIPT, SONG & DANCE MEMORISATION - It is expected that all students learn, practice and memorise all their lines, songs, and choreography by the dates assigned. Start learning lines and songs right away so you don't have to worry about it!

APDROPRIATE DRESS - Please wear loose, comfortable clothing that allows you to bend, stretch, run, jump, dance, etc. while at rehearsal.

CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

Please note - Singing range is a guide to how it is written on the score. Feel free to sing any song you are comfortable in any chosen octave.

Spongebob SquarePants (Singing range A2 to G#4): Spongebob is optimistic, innocent, and boyish; energetic and sometimes hyperactive. This actor should have the ability to move well and be an extremely physical actor - unafraid of climbing. Additionally: Must be naturally funny and have great comedic skills and precision.

Squidward Q. Tentacles (Singing range A2 to G#4 belt): Grumpy, cynical, dry, short tempered, generally negative but loveable! This Actor must move well and TAP dancing skills is a plus.

Patrick Star (Singing range A2 to F#4): Well-intentioned but lacking common sense or skills; kind and somewhat clueless, an innocent; a big softie, who can also be prone to sudden child-like fits of rage or frustration

Sheldon J. Plankton (Singing range A2 to G4): Sheldon's personality outweighs his size-slick, scheming, nefarious; has the ability to charm; determined, he will do anything to get ahead in life; very greedy, but his heart is still open enough to rekindle a romance with his wife. This character will need to dance and rap skills are a plus.

Karen the Computer (Singing range A3 to D5): Glamorous, a robotic housewife of Plankton. She's been there for Plankton's every scheme and plot and has become jaded - she's been there and done that. Strong comic actress, as well as Singer and Mover.

Pearl Krabs (Singing range B3 to E5): Mr. Krabs' bratty teenage daughter. This is a character role with Gospel vocal overtones.

Sandy Cheeks (Singing range A3 to E5): A brainy and athletic Texan squirrel who came to Bikini Bottom for a research project. She acts as SpongeBob's most trusted ally on their quest to stop the volcano from erupting, using her vast amount of scientific knowledge and brilliant inventions to aid the mission.

Mr. Eugene Crabs (Singing range D3 to G4): The greedy owner of the Krusty Krab, and employer of SpongeBob and Squidward. While everyone is off panicking about Bikini Bottom's imminent doom, he decides to strike the iron while it's hot and puts on a huge "apocalypse sale" at his restaurant, exploiting the fear of his fellow fish to make him even richer.

ACTING TIPS - These Characters are iconic. They are larger than their line count and number of lines sung. They tell the story with their voice and physical movement. Theatre is looking for strong characters, energetic character traits, character choices to help tell our story in a LIVELY way while remaining truthful to the story. There are links to these on the school website as well.

Sandy: Well I've got news, hot off the griddle. I did some calculations...and that volcano is gonna erupt, as sure as a rhinestone cowboy at a disco rodeo. I figured out when, too. It's gonna happen at sundown - tomorrow. I'm serious as a guacamole shortage at a taco party. I determined the timeline through analysis of seismic activity, gas emissions, geomagnetic and gravimetric changes.

SpongeBob: No, Mr. Krabs! I'll find a way to stop that volcano! We'll use science, like Sandy said. We can use her jetpack to get to the top! Wait, pretty sure it's only built for one. I guess everyone was right. This will be the end....unless I can stop it. Gotta get my team together. I am not a Simple Sponge. We'll have to climb it, then. Patrick can help with that. He's super strong. Sandy's brains plus Patrick's brawn plus my ... I'm not sure what my thing is. But that won't stop me.

Squidward: I for one, have my sights set beyond this place. I've been developing a oneman show starring an as yet undiscovered, young, handsome and very leggy...talent. I call it: Tentacle Spectacle, the Musical. I still remember that night, my third-great talent show, the other fish calling me Loser! Loser! To this day, when I hear that word, something in me just SNAPS! **Plankton:** Oh yes, it is! What you said was true: it would take too long to hypnotise each of them into loving my chum burgers. But when fish are scared, they school together. If I get them all in one place, trapped where there's nowhere to run, I can hypnotise them in bulk! First, though, I need to shut down this squirrel. I have a new scheme, Karen, my best one yet. But for it to work, I need them to stay scared!

Patrick: But you don't understand. I'm stuck inside and I can't watch any of my shows. Because all that's on TV is THIS! The inner machinations of my mind are an enigma ... I don't know what METAPHORICALLY MEANS! OUR team needs a name: PatBob. PatBobSpongeRick? Finally someone understands the inner machinations of my mind!

Mayor of Bikini Bottom: We'll order the escape pod, cash on delivery. Expedited shipping by six p.m. next business day. Just in time to get us out before sundown tomorrow. And it only costsNEPTUNE's TRIDENT!

Pearl: I can't decide what to wear for the Electric Skates. You don't understand me. Maybe it's because we're not the same species. Which is pretty weird now that I think about it.
