Saturday 29th August - 2pm and 7pm. All cast will be required at the theatre 2 hours before any show.

4. **SCRIPT, SONG & DANCE MEMORISATION** - It is expected that all students learn, practice and memorise all their lines, songs, and choreography by the dates assigned! Always give your BEST! Give 100 % to your singing, acting & dancing!
5. Listen to instructions and follow directions the 1st time.
6. Go with the flow! Sometimes things change and we have to be ready to just move on.
7. Be Prepared! Wear loose, comfortable clothing that allows you to bend, stretch, run, jump, dance. Always bring your script and a pencil/eraser to make notes and write down blocking.

Cinderella

Everyone keeps asking if I'm happy.

And I always say yes — because that's what a *happy ending* looks like, right?

Glass slippers, a castle, a prince who smiles perfectly on cue.

But here's the thing no one tells you...

Happily ever after doesn't come with instructions.

I love my life — I really do — but sometimes I wonder who I'd be if I stopped doing what I was *supposed* to do, and started doing what I actually want.

What if the story doesn't end here?

What if this is just the beginning?

I'm not ungrateful.

I'm curious.

And maybe that's brave.

Or maybe it's terrifying.

But if there's one thing I've learned, it's that magic doesn't just happen *to* you.

Sometimes... you have to choose it yourself.

Snow White

Oh! Hi!

Sorry — I was just finishing a thought... or starting one... I'm not sure which.

Everyone keeps saying we should talk about things, but I don't really see the need.

Everything's fine.

If something was wrong, I'd feel it... right?

Besides, stories always work themselves out.

That's kind of their thing.

I like routines. Book club, tea, smiling politely — it's all very soothing.

And if you don't ask too many questions, nothing gets complicated.

So yes, I'm happy.

Very happy.

At least... I think I am.

Anyway!

What were we talking about?

Prince Charming

Right.

So everything's... going exactly as planned.

The kingdom's happy. I look good in the portraits.

Cinderella smiles. I smile back.

It's very balanced.

I don't really overthink things — that's what advisors are for.

And books.

And... people who like that sort of thing.

My job is simple: show up, be charming, and keep the story moving forward.

Which I do.

Exceptionally well, actually.

If there were a problem, someone would've told me.

And no one has.

So... no problem.

Anyway — I should probably get back to being admired.

Busy day.

Narrator

I'm very glad to hear that. Because these fairy tales, they teach children how to see the world. What to fear. Whom to love. What happy ever after means. And so if we start changing things ... we might as well take away their north star! The very light that guides them through their childhoods!

(snapping)

No I don't think you do. Cinderella, you told me you felt "lonely." Do you know where you'll really feel lonely? Story's End.

Stepmother

A "book", is that what it's called? Noted. And no.

(watching BELINDA go)

Should I have educated her? Motherhood is such a series of difficult decisions

(back to CINDERELLA)

I'm sure a trade could be arranged. You can have that "book" back ... if you reject the Prince.

Cinderella. Why do you think I do this? Night after night? If I didn't think

someday there might be a different outcome? If I didn't think at SOME point the Narrator might be "persuaded" to have the Prince choose either of my perfect daughters.

Sweetheart-if the Narrator deigns to make an adjustment, that's what the Great Quill is for!

"Who's the fairest?" I think it's an open question ...

Belinda and Betany

Okay, I'm not saying anything —

I'm just saying... if something *were* wrong, we would've noticed.

Because we notice things.

Like tones. And vibes. And when someone's smile is slightly too tight.

But everything's fine!

Totally fine.

Probably.

I mean, if the story *was* changing, someone would've told us.

Right?

...Right?

Fairy Godmother

Sweetie, I want YOU to look for you. I've been waiting forever for a princess in this kingdom to ask for something that didn't involve fabric.

Open it! Cinderella. The stories you've been reading, and living ... they can be deeply problematic. Towards certain people. They just can give you a very warped view of the world. The real world. Out there, beyond Story's End.

Sweetie ... women do write. And they influence ... And they agitate.

Prince Eurudite

Oh! Narrator! SO. I realize I'm basically just a member of Charming's entourage but I'd love to talk to you about my character arc because as they say, there are no small parts, only small-

(to CLUMSY)

That is NOT directed at you. You're....

(yikes!)

Adorable.

(nonchalant)

Agreeable.

Clumsy

Okay — just to be clear —

this is *not* my fault.

I was standing perfectly still...
and then the chair moved.
Aggressively.

I'm actually very capable.
I just have... enthusiastic limbs.

But it's fine! Everything's fine.
Nothing's broken.
(beat)
Well — nothing *important*.

I'll just... put this down very carefully...
and—
Yep.
Still fine.

Other Princesses, Princes, Ensemble

I mean... my story's fine.
Great, actually.
Everything's exactly how it's supposed to be — the dress, the ending, the expectations.
It's all very tidy.

I don't really question it.
Why would I?
The story's been working just fine without my input.

So yes — I'm happy.
Absolutely.
No notes.

...Why does everyone keep asking?
